Capodanno, MM Presentation and Memorial Mass, September 16, 2023-a Diocesan - Wide Presentation and Mass, held at St. James Parish, Liberty, MO.

Meeting began with opening prayer and the recitation of Catholic War, Veterans, (CWV) USA (Est. 1935, Monsignor Higgins, Pope Pius XI) Post Rituals, Pledge of Allegiance, & Preamble. Fr. Michael Volkmer, C.PP.S., & Commander Larry Bergeron presided over these rituals.
