We were also honored to have attending several Native Americans from the Apache Nation. One of

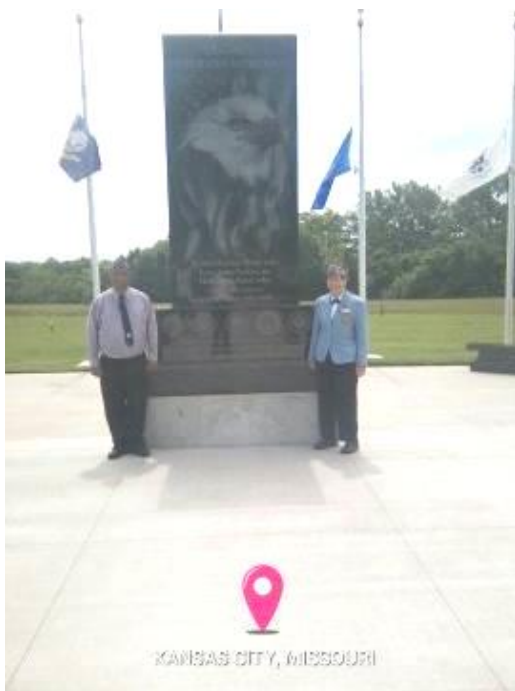

If you order you cover from the national office, the cost is \$48.00. That consists of the cover, the patch, 1974 on front left, and Liberty, MO along the right side.
